	<p>recommendation is to grant funds for the Village of Cairo for total reconstruction of Main Street from the municipal border on the west side to the municipal border on the east side. The allocation is \$134,000, of which \$26,800 will be allocated for administration, environmental, etc. Village of Cairo would receive \$107,200 to go towards their \$1.9 million project. The rest of the funding consists of monies from ODOT and the Ohio Public Works Commission. The Village of Cairo will also be applying for a Competitive Infrastructure Grant. Bath Township also submitted an application to receive funds for a street project from McCullough Street from Robb Avenue to 100' north of Daytona Drive. This is a contingency project in the event the Village of Cairo project does not proceed.</p>
